

Dexter Mosley Act (Grades 6-12)

Under the Dexter Mosley Act (Senate Bill 51), home study students in grades six through 12 are eligible to participate in extracurricular and interscholastic activities in the Douglas County School District. In order to participate, home study students shall complete at least one qualifying course during any semester the student participates in an extracurricular or interscholastic activity. A “qualifying course” means an on-site course, an online course facilitated by the Douglas County School District or a dual enrollment course. Participation is only available at the public school in which a home study student would be enrolled based on his or her residence.

Deadlines to Apply

Fall Semester 2024: July 1, 2024

Spring Semester 2025: December 1, 2024

Items Needed for Registration

- Certified copy of the student's Birth Certificate
- State required Immunization Georgia Form 3231 (marked complete for school attendance)
- State required Vision, Hearing, Dental & Nutrition (BMI) Georgia Form 3300 (forms must be completed within one calendar year prior to enrollment for the 1st time entering a GA public school)
- Student's Social Security Card or Waiver
- Parent/Guardian Proof of Identification
- Custody/Guardianship Paperwork (if applicable)
- Withdrawal Form from the previous school (if applicable)
- Last Report Card (if applicable)
- Discipline History for Middle and High School Students
- Student's Transcript for all High School Students
- Proof of Residency
- Written statement by the home study program instructor that verifies the student is currently receiving a passing grade in each home study course, is maintaining satisfactory progress toward advancement and meets the requirements for participation in the specified activity
