AHS Scholarships Earned

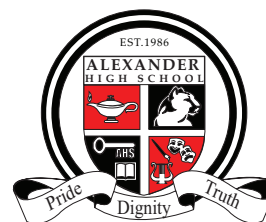
The AHS Class of 2019 earned over \$11.8 million in scholarships.

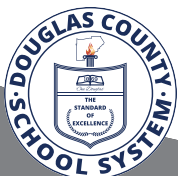
